OREGON'S NEW AND USED ELECTRIC CAR REBATES

\$2,500 - Standard Rebate
(for a *new* electric car)

\$2,500 - Charge Ahead Rebate
(for a *new or used* electric car based on income)

\$5,000 - Standard + Charge Ahead Rebate
(for a *new* electric car based on income)

\$7,500 - Federal Tax Credit



Who Qualifies?

	Standard Rebate	Charge Ahead Rebate
Eligible applicants	Oregon residents, businesses, non-profits & Govt. agencies	Oregon residents
Qualifying vehicles	New battery electric vehicles and plug-in hybrid vehicles	New or used battery electric vehicles and plug-in hybrid vehicles
Income requirement	No Income requirement	Up to 120% of median household income
Rebate Amount	\$1,500 for a battery under 10kWh, \$2,500 for a battery over 10kWh	\$2,500

Charging is fast, easy and accessible

There are over 1600 public chargers in 600 locations in Oregon

The **Standard Rebate** offers up to **\$2,500** when you buy or lease a **new** electric car in Oregon priced under \$50,000.

The **Charge Ahead Rebate** offers up to **\$2,500** when you buy or lease a **new or used** electric car in Oregon whose base price is under \$50,000 and you earn up to 120% of the median household income in your county.

Qualifying applicants can **combine both rebates**. If you earn up to 120% of the median household income in your county, **and** buy a **new** electric car priced under \$50,000, get up to **\$5,000 in rebates!**

Based on the vehicle manufacturer, the **Federal Tax Credit** ranges from **\$2,500 - \$7,500** for **new** battery electric and plug-in hybrid vehicles, deducted from your tax liability.

If you are purchasing or leasing your car from a dealer, you may be able to receive your Oregon rebate at the time of purchase as cash on the hood.
